Richard Valpy: Angulalik. He would take his schooner the Tudlik to Herschel?

Scotty Gall: To Herschel yes.

Richard Valpy: And Clarke, he would also take a boat to...

Scotty Gall: Yes he did. The Niglik, which was his supply boat. And he'd make two trips. He'd go in and out. That's why he wouldn't freeze in at Cambridge Bay. He used to try and freeze in at Bathurst. So he could get away quick and get out and get the first load in.

Richard Valpy: And make two trips a year.

Scotty Gall: Yes, if there is ice around it takes quite a lot.
